carried out in accordance with the provisions of Article 3 of the Constitution. No proposals regarding the Kulu Valley have been received by the Government of India either from Himachal Pradesh Government or the Punjab Government. In any event Government of India do not consider the present an opportune time for this question of boundary adjustments to be raised.
