

## ADMISSION OF STUDENTS

\*708. SHRI K. C. GEORGE: Will the Minister for DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) how many trainees are admitted every year in the Air Force Technical School at Jalahali, Bangalore;

(b) what is the total number of trainees trained so far in that school; and

(c) what is the expenditure incurred in this regard?

THE MINISTER FOR DEFENCE ORGANIZATION (SHRI MAHAVIR TYAGI): (a) The hon. Member presumably refers to the two Training Institutions at Jalahalli, namely,

(i) Technical Training College, Jalahalli; and

(ii) No. 3 Ground Training School, Jalahalli. On an average, 40 to 50 officers and 150 to 200 apprentices are admitted every year in the Technical Training College; and 300 to 400 Airmen are admitted into No. 3 Ground Training School, Jalahalli.

(b) I am afraid an official disclosure of this information is apt to be misconstrued. I would, therefore, appeal to my hon. friend not to press for this information.

(c) This information is not readily available and will be laid on the table of the House in due course.

## ALLOTMENT OF LANDS TO DISPLACED PERSONS

\*709. LT.-COL. J. S. MANN: Will the Minister for REHABILITATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that some displaced persons from the Amritsar District (West Pakistan) were allotted land in Hoshiarpur District;

(b) if the reply to part (a) above be in the affirmative, the number of families which were allotted land in Hoshiarpur District; and

(c) whether any one of them has since been evicted; if so, why?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR REHABILITATION (SHRI J. K. BHONSLE): (a) to (c). The information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House in due course.

## INDIAN INVESTMENT IN FOREIGN COUNTRIES

(a) which are the Indian investments in foreign countries which are giving an yield of four per cent. and more; and

(b) what is the percentage of these investments to the total of the Indian foreign investment?

THE MINISTER FOR FINANCE (SHRI C. D. DESHMUKH): (a) and (b). Government have no information in regard to the return on private investments. In regard to investments by official and semi-official institutions, the return is almost, in all cases, less than 4 per cent.
