SPICES ENQUIRY COMMITTEE

*243. SHRI M. VALIULLA: Will the Minister for FOOD AND AGRICUL-TURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Indian Council of Agricultural Research has set up a Fact Finding Committee to inquire into certain matters relating to spices;
- (b) when the Committee was set up;
- (c) whether it has submitted its report, if not, when it is expected to do so;
- (d) what is the strength of the Committee; and
- (e) how many of its members are members of the Indian Council Agricultural Research?

SHRI M. VALIULLA: How many times did they meet so far?

Dr. P. S. DESHMUKH: They met first in the middle of September, 1951 and they circulated a comprehensive questionnaire to the State Government and to interested groups like the Chambers of Commerce etc. The Committee has finished its preliminary work in Travancore-Cochin and is expected to start enquiry sometime in December for getting first-hand information in Madras, Mysore, Coorg, Bombay and Orissa.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: How many times has it met?

Dr. P. S. DESHMUKH: It has met only once and it is now going or tour to investigate on the spot.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: Has the Committee been asked to give report not only or pepper but also on other articles?

Dr. P. S. DESHMUKH: Yes.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: What are those articles?

Dr. P. S. DESHMUKH: They have not been enumerated. But all the principal items would be looked into.

SHRI GOVINDA REDDY: Is the Committee calling for any opinions from the growers of these crops?

Dr. P. S. DESHMUKH: As I have already stated the questionnaire has been issued and the growers will certainly be included.

SHRI GOVINDA REDDY: Has the Committee toured the places also?
