SHRI S. MAHANTY: Will the hon. Minister please say since when this proposal has been under consideration?

Mr. CHAIRMAN: Since when this proposal has been under consideration ?

SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR: I have not got the exact date of the representation but I think during the course of the year.

SHRI S. MAHANTY: Is it not strange, Sir, that your files do not contain the information which we require? e .7 e . 19

SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR: At the moment, it does not contain. Whether it is strange or not is another matter. I said 'during this year'.

SHRI S. MAHANTY: Has the Government any idea as to what will be the average consumption of electrical energy in this plant?

SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR: should have notice for giving detailed estimates of electric energy that is to be consumed by the plant.

MR. CHAIRMAN: Questions are over.
