THE MINISTER FOR PLANNING AND IRRIGATION AND POWER (SHRI GULZARI LAL NANDA): (*a*) The final figures for 1951-52 are not yet available. The total development expenditure during 1951-52 of the Central Government for the year is estimated to be Rs. 179 crores and of the State Governments Rs. 138 crores. to Questions

90. SHRI M. VALIULLA : Will the Minister for LABOUR be pleased to state :

(fc) how many of them are graduates, matriculates and non-matriculates ?

EXPORT OF COAL

91. SHRI M. VALIULLA : Will the Minister for PRODUCTION be pleased to State:

(a) the total tonnage of coal that India exported in the year 1951 and what is the quantity likely to be exported in 1952;

(fc) the names of the countries to whichIndian coal was exported in1951 and is likely to be exported in1952 ; and

(c) the quantity of coal required for annual consumption in India.

THE MINISTER FOR PRODUCTION (SHRI K. C. REDDY) : (a) 2,798,272 tons. Quantity likely to be exported in 1952, is about the same.

(fc) A statement giving the information is laid on the Table of the House. *[See* Appendix II, Annexure No. 42.]

(c) The total requirements of coal for internal consumption are assessed at between 30 and 31 million tons per annum, at present.
