

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS (SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The targets of capacity and production of chemicals fertilizers for the Fourth Plan period have been fixed at 2.2 million tonnes and 2 million tonnes, respectively, in terms of nitrogen. For phosphatic fertilizers a target of production of one million tonnes of P2O5 has been fixed.

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(c) The total investment envisaged is as follows:

Nitrogenous fertilisers—Rs. 306.3 crores.

Phosphatic fertilizers—Rs. 20.0 | crores.

MISHRA): (a) and (b) The Chief Commissioner of Delhi has decided to reserve 15 per cent, of the plots earmarked for the individuals of the low income group for allotment to the widows of the Defence personnel killed in action. It has been further decided that in making these allotments, the condition fixed by the Chief Commissioner that only such individuals could apply for allotment of plots earmarked for the individuals of the low income group as had ordinarily been residing continuously in the Union Territory of Delhi for the last five years, will be relaxed.
