Ceylon Electricity Board (CEB) for carrying out the Feasibility Study for interconnection of the India-Sri Lanka Electricity Grids, which inter-alia indudes setting up of High Voltage Direct Current (HVDC) Transmission system between the two countries involving under sea transmission as well.

As per the MOU, both PGCIL and CEB are 'Executing Agencies' for carrying out the above mentioned study and would compile data/details of their assigned activities and jointly complete the entire Feasibility Study. PGCIL would carry out all activities related to the land portion which falls in India and the entire sea portions, whereas CEB would carry out all activities related to Sri Lankan land portion. PGCIL has already completed the assigned work as per the MOU.

While CEB is carrying out the works assigned to it, it has placed a Letter of Award (LoA) on PGCIL on 16th August, 2011 for carrying out some portion of their work. PGCIL has started the work as per LoA of CEB.

The entire work related to this Feasibility Study is expected to be completed by 31st December 2011, as agreed to in the Task Force and Steering Committee Meetings held on 3-4 August, 2011 at New Delhi.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRI K.C. VENUGOPAL): (a) Accelerated Power Development and Reforms Programme (APDRP) was launched in 2002-03 as

Additional Central Assistance to the states for strengthening and up gradation of sub-transmission and distribution systems with main objectives of reduction in AT&C and commercial losses and improvement in quality and reliability of supply of power.

Ten states have shown reduction of cash loss amounting to Rs.5809.89 Crore and became eligible for APDRP incentive of Rs.2904.95 Crore, which has been released to the states. State-wise details given in the Statement-II (Sea below).

R-APDRP:

Total fund utilized

The Restructured-Accelerated Power Development and Reforms Programme (R-APDRP) was launched by the Ministry of Power in July 2008 as a Central Sector Scheme for improving the urban power distribution sector in the country. Power Finance Corporation (PFC) is the nodal agency to operationalize the R-APDRP programme.

The projects under the R-APDRP scheme are taken up in two parts: Part-A & Part-B. Part-A includes the projects for IT applications for energy accounting/ auditing, GIS, consumer indexing, SCADA & IT based consumer service centers etc. and Part-B for system strengthening of distribution network.

A total of Rs.25,527 Crores has been sanctioned & Rs.4,052 Crores has been disbursed till 29.08.2011 to the state power distribution utilities for taking up projects under R-APDRP. State-wise details are given in the Statement-III (See below).

(b) and (c) Under 10th Plan Accelerated Power Development Reforms Programme (APDRP), Rs.74.02 Crores were released by Government of India to the state of Orissa for 7 projects sanctioned at an estimated eost of Rs.502.22 Crores (revised to Rs.130.11 Crores after completion/short closure as on 31.03.2009).

As per approved scheme, areas under private utilities are not covered under R-APDRP. Distribution of Electricity in Orissa is privatized and therefore not covered under R-APDRP.

The proposal for participation of private utilities in R-APDRP is under consideration in Government of India.
