#### **Metro line in cities of Uttar Pradesh**

†1221. SHRI JAI PRAKASH: Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has conducted any survey for laying Metro line like 'Delhi Metro' in cities of Uttar Pradesh excluding Ghaziabad and Gautam Buddh Nagar;
- (b) the cities of Uttar Pradesh, where such metro line is proposed to be laid;
- (c) whether Government has given 'in-principle' approval to their proposal; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SAUGATA RAY): (a) No, Sir. Central Government has not conducted any such survey.

(b) to (d) Question does not arise. It is clarified that urban transport being State subject, it is upto the State Government to get feasibility study done and in suitable cases get the Detailed Project Report (DPR) prepared and approved by the State Government. Thereafter, the State Government sends the proposal for approval of the Central Government. In case of Uttar Pradesh no such proposal has been received.

#### **Urban development of North Eastern States**

1222. SHRI O. T. LEPCHA: Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government proposes to provide special economic package to North Eastern States particularly in Sikkim for urban development;
- (b) if so, the State-wise details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SAUGATA RAY): (a) The Ministry of Urban Development has no proposal to provide for a special economic package to North Eastern States including Sikkim for urban development.

(b) Does not arise in view of above.

(c) The Ministry of Urban Development is already supporting infrastructure development in urban areas of the North-Eastern States including Sikkim through

various schemes like 10% Lumpsum provision scheme for benefit of North Eastern States including Sikkim; Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission; Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns and North Eastern Region Urban Development Programme.

**Water crisis in Arambagh Government colony**

†1223. SHRI O. T. LEPCHA: Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether in some Government colonies of Delhi, particularly in Aram bagh, 3.50 lakh litre of water is being supplied against the demand of 11 lakh litre due to the differences between Central Public Works Department and Delhi Jal Board;

(b) if so, the number of meetings held on this matter among the Resident Welfare Association, Central Public Works Department and Delhi Jal Board during the last three years;

(c) the details thereof; and

(d) the reasons for discrimination by Delhi Jal Board regarding supply of water to Government Colony, Aram Bagh and New Delhi Municipal Corporation?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SAUGATA RAY): (a) 3.50 to 4.00 lakhs litres of water is supplied by Delhi Jal Board (DJB) against the demand of 10.75 lakh litres per day. DJB has informed that they supply the water to its consumers as per availability and feasibility without any discrimination.

(b) and (c) Four meetings have been held amongst RWA, CPWD and DJB. However lot of correspondences have been made by RWA and CPWD with DJB to increase the water supply. The details of the meetings held are as follows:—

(i) 01.02.2010 — between Chief Engineer, DJB and Chief Engineer CPWD.

(ii) 31.01.2011 — between RWA and Chief Engineer, CPWD

(iii) 11.05.2011 — between CPWD, RWA and DJB

(iv) 28.05.2011 — between DJB, RWA and CPWD with Hon'ble Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports, Shri Ajay Maken.
