Improvement in financial condition of the Grameen Banks

†1583. SHRI JAI PRAKASH: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of progress made in connection with a Central Scheme under which the target was fixed for improving the financial status of 86 regional rural banks till March 2012;
- (b) whether Government would delegate the responsibility of disbursing the loans amounting to Rs. 50,500 crore to the Grameen banks, as committed for earlier; and
 - (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI NAMO NARAIN MEENA): (a) At present 82 Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) are functioning in the country. The Committee on Capital-to-Risk-Weighted Assets Ratio (CRAR) had recommended for recapitalisation of select RRBs to bring their CRAR to 9% by March, 2012. Accordingly, an amount of i 66.49 crore was released during the year 2010-11 to capitalize 5 RRBs. During the year 2011-12, so far, an amount of i 31.25 crore has been released to capitalize 3 RRBs.

(b) and (c) The RRBs have been allocated a target of i 50,500 crore for credit to agricultural and allied activities for the year 2011-12.
