Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that there lies a shortage of hands to deal with the routine jobs in Income Tax Department such as tax refunds etc. causing delays to the tax payers;
 - (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that refund cheques if sent back by the tax payers for any corrections are not returned after carrying necessary corrections easily ordinarily and ordinarily takes a period of 3-4 years;
- (d) whether Government is actively considering to take any expeditious step to fill up the vacant posts to ease the work pressure;
 - (e) if so, the details thereof; and
 - (f) if not, the reasons therefor?

Meetings of Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) are also held periodically, as per Government of India instructions.
