- (a) the details of the funds allocated to Rajasthan for its different sanctuaries, sanctuary-wise;
- (b) whether the State Government has utilized this fund in the stipulated time; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARAJAN): (a) to (c) As per the information available in the Ministry, there are 5 National Parks and 23 Sanctuaries notified under Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 in the State of Rajasthan. The Ministry provides financial assistance to the State Governments for development of Wildlife Protected Areas, including National Parks and Sanctuaries, under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats, Project Elephant and Project Tiger. During the Financial Year 2010-11, financial assistance was provided to 16 protected areas in the State of Rajasthan. Financial assistance for the current financial year has not yet been released. Sanctuary-wise details of funds allocated and utilized by the State Government of Rajasthan during the financial year 2010-11 are given in the statement.
