THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (DR. SHAKEEL AHMAD): (a) The number of post offices set up in North Eastern Region including the State of Arunachal Pradesh during the last three years are given below:

No Plan support has been given in 2004-05 as no plan targets were given for opening post offices. New Post offices were opened in 2004-2005 only through relocation of existing post offices.
