

#### **Monitoring of social networking sites**

1924. SHRI T.M. SELVAGANAPATHI: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the country has been witnessing usage of mobile phones and Internet for crimes being committed which were against the interest of the nation;

(b) whether it is also a fact that Government has taken a decision to monitor all social networking sites; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI SACHIN PILOT): (a) Yes Sir. With the increase in the proliferation of the Mobile phones, Internet and related services, there is a rise in the number of Crimes and Cyber Security incidents. The trend in increase in Cyber incidents is similar to that worldwide.

#### **Mobile service delivery gateway**

(a) whether the Department of Information Technology has published a draft policy on mobile governance that aims to enable Government Departments to offer services such as payment of utility bills and filing of Tax returns through mobile phones;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether Government has decided to set up a platform called Mobile Service Delivery Gateway on which all Ministries/ Departments can start this service; and

(d) if so, the details thereof;

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI SACHIN PILOT): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The Government has prepared a draft Mobile Governance Policy Framework which aims to enable delivery of public services by leveraging mobile technology. The details are given in Statement-I (See below).
