A budgetary allocation of Rs. 100.00 crore (Additional Central Assistance - Rs.60.7 crore; RKVY - Rs.25.00 crore; Ongoing CS/CSS schemes of DADF - 10.15 crore; State Share - Rs.4.15 crore) was approved by Planning Commission, Government of India in 2009-10 for implementing Animal Husbandry activities in six districts of Bundelkhand region of Madhya Pradesh. The first instalment ACA component of Rs. 20.88 crore was released On 30.8.2010. The second instalment of Rs. 29.46 crore was released to the State on 5.9.2011. The balance amount of Rs. 10.36 crore under Additional Central Assistance (ACA) would be released by the Planning Commission after receipt of necessary

utilization certificate and physical progress report from Government of Madhya Pradesh .

Under RKVY, the State Government of Madhya Pradesh has been advised to earmark Rs. 25 crore from the allocation of RKVY scheme for Bundelkhand Region during 2011-12. At present, no proposal is pending from Madhya Pradesh State under RKVY.
