## Commercial utilization of surplus railway land

1971. SHRI N.K. SINGH:

SHRIMATI SHOBHANA BHARTIA:

Will tlie Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Railways have formulated any action plan for commercial utilization of surplus Railv/ay land;
  - (b) if so, the details thereof; and
  - (c) the criteria, for such commeicial facilities to be set up at various sites?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BHARATSINH SOLANKI): (a) to (c) Vacant Railway land not required by Railways for immediate future operational needs is utilised for commercial development, wherever feasible as per the extant Government Guidelines. In this regard, Rail Land Development Authority (RLOA) a statutory body has been set up through the Railway (Amendment) Act, 2005 to undertake commercial development. So far, 135 sites have been identified and developers have been finalised for five sites.

Commercial facilities to be developed will be ascertained after a detailed study for each site by reputed consultants. The study is based on detailed market analysis and State Government/local bodies bye-laws.
