

**Security audit of CISF**

1009. SHRI GOVINDRAO ADIK :

SHRI SANJAY RAUT :

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state :

- (a) whether it is a fact that Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) has commissioned a security audit;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that it has identified grey areas in airport security at Delhi airport;
- (c) whether CISF has asked for 30 per cent more force to secure airport; and
- (d) if so, the reaction of the Ministry to the proposal?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN): (a) and (b) No Sir. Security audit of airports is a part of Quality Control Programme conducted by the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS), periodically at all airports.

(c) and (d) BCAS has constituted a committee for manpower survey of CISF at Delhi airport. The Ministry of Home Affairs is yet to receive the recommendations of the committee.

**Attacks by extremist groups in NE states**

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state :

- (a) whether attacks by extremist groups in north-eastern States including Assam, have been reported recently;
- (b) if so, the State-wise details of casualties of Hindi-speaking people along with other citizens in these attacks during the current year; and
- (c) the steps taken by Government to stop such activities in above regions of the country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN): (a) Yes, Sir. The underground outfits engage in unlawful activities including attacks on security forces, innocent civilians etc. in the North Eastern States.

(b) State-wise details of the casualties of people, including Hindi speaking people, reported in the North Eastern States, including Assam during the current year 2011 (up to 15.11.2011) are as under:

| State             | Incidents | Security Forces killed | Civilians killed<br>(Hindi speaking) |

| Assam             | 128       | 128                    | 16                                   |

(c) Concerted efforts are being made by the State Governments in the region to counter such activities of the groups. The Central Government is supplementing their efforts through various measures such as deployment of additional Central Security Forces for carrying out intensive counter insurgency operations and providing security for vulnerable installations and projects, based on threat assessments; sharing of intelligence; financial assistance for strengthening of the local Police Forces and intelligence agencies under the Police Modernization scheme; assistance for strengthening various aspects of security apparatus and other aspects of anti-militancy operations by way of reimbursement of Security Related Expenditure; raising of additional Forces in the form of India Reserve Battalions; etc. The Central Government is maintaining close and continuous coordination with the State Government in the region.
