rehabilitation of naxalites in the naxal affected States as a model to the States which, inter alia provides for an immediate grant of Rs.1.5 lakh, a stipend of Rs.2000 for three years, vocational training and incentives for surrender of weapons.

The State-wise details of naxalites surrendered in 2009, 2010 and 2011 (up to 15th Nov) are given in Statement.

## Confiscation of consignment of Ammonium Nitrate

1019. SHRI JAI PRAKASH NARAYAN SINGH: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that several consignment of Ammonium Nitrate has been confiscated from various States recently;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that the Ammonium Nitrate is being used for illegal mining in various States;
- (c) whether Government has received compliant that Ammonium Nitrate for illegal mining is imported and comes from Visakhapatnam port in loose form;

- (d) whether Government has taken into account the method Ammonium Nitrate is being imported in loose form into the country; and
- (e) if so, the concrete steps taken so far to stop the pilferage from ports by compulsorily importing the Ammonium Nitrate in sealed bags instead of loose form?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) There is no specific report.
- (c) No, Sir. There is no report of any such complaint having been received.
- (d) and (e) Central Government vide Ministry of Commerce and Industries (Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion) Notification No. S.O. 1678(E) dated 21.7.2011 has declared that Ammonium Nitrate having the chemical formula NH4 N03 or any combination containing more than 45 per cent of Ammonium Nitrate by weight including emulsions, suspensions, melts or gels (with or without inorganic nitrates) shall be deemed to be an explosive within the meaning of the Explosives Act, 1884 (IV of 1884). Provided that such Ammonium Nitrate or any combination thereof shall not include those fertilizers from which Ammonium Nitrate cannot be extracted by any physical or chemical process. The draft Ammonium Nitrates Rules 2011 have been framed *vide* Gazette Notification No.GSR 694(E), dated 16.09.2011 by Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion with a view to regulate its use for bonafide purpose by incorporating provisions relating to its sale, manufacture, transport, storage, use, import/export, packaging etc.
