

Homeless households in the country

1041. DR. T.N. SEEMA: Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise total number of homeless households in the country as on 1 April, 2011;
- (b) how many houses were completed/provided under the Central Government housing schemes for poor during the last five years, State-wise;
- (c) how many houses are estimated to be completed under the Central Government housing schemes for homeless poor sections in the next five years;
- (d) whether Government has received any proposal for Central assistance for urban employment guarantee schemes from Kerala and other States, like the NREGA Scheme; and
- (e) whether Government has given any assistance to the above scheme?

THE MINISTER OF HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION (KUMARI SELJA): (a) The Census of India, 2011 data on total no. of house holds is yet to be published by Registrar General of India (RGI). However, the Census of India, 2001 had estimated 4,47,585 houseless households throughout the country. State-wise detail of houseless households in the country as per 2001 Census is given in Statement-I (See below).

(b) The National Urban Housing & Habitat Policy (NUHHP) 2007 aims at promoting sustainable development of habitat in the country with a view to ensuring equitable supply of land shelter and services at affordable prices to all sections of the society. However, 'Land' and 'Colonisation' being State subjects, it is for the State Governments to pursue the initiatives under the NUHHP: 2007.

The Central Government is supporting the construction of housing for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) and Low Income Groups (LIG) sections of the society in urban areas through various programmatic interventions viz.,

- The Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM), launched by the Government in the year 2005 supports provision of housing and basic services to urban poor in slums in 65 specified cities under the Sub Mission Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP)

and in other cities and towns under the Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP). As on 31.03.2011. State-wise details of progress made under BSUP and IHSDP during the last five years are given in Statement-II and III respectively (See below).

- The Interest Subsidy Scheme for Housing the Urban Poor (ISHUP) provides for interest subsidy on housing loans to the Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) and Low Income Group (LIG) as part of credit-enablement measures and encourages those households to avail of loan facilities through Commercial Banks/Housing Finance Companies for the purposes of construction/acquisition of houses and avail 5% subsidy in interest payment for loans upto Rs. 1 lakh. State-wise detail of progress made under ISHUP since its inception i.e. 26.12.2008 is given in Statement-IV (See below).
- The scheme of Affordable Housing in Partnership seeks assembly of land for construction of affordable housing and provides Central Government assistance towards provision of internal and external infrastructure connectivity. The scheme which was launched in 2009 with an outlay of 5000 crores, seeks construction of 1 million houses for EWS/LIG/Middle Income Group (MIG) with at least 25% for EWS Category. The cumulative progress made under the scheme is given in Statement-V (See below).
- A new scheme 'Rajiv Awas Yojana' (RAY) has been launched on 02.06.2011. The Phase I of Rajiv Awas Yojana (RAY) is for a period of two years from the date of approval of the scheme with a budget of Rs. 5,000 crores. The Scheme will provide financial assistance to States that are willing to assign property rights to slum dwellers for provision of decent shelter and basic civic and social services for slum redevelopment, and for creation of affordable housing stock. Fifty percent (50%) of the cost of provision of basic civic and social infrastructure and amenities and of housing, including rental housing, and transit housing for in-situ redevelopment - in slums would be borne by the Centre, including operation & maintenance of assets created under this scheme. For the North Eastern and Special Category States the share of the Centre would be 90% including the cost of land acquisition, if required. Funds have been released to 157 cities for undertaking preparatory activities under Slum Free City Planning Scheme - the preparatory phase of Rajiv Awas Yojana. List of the 157 cities is given in Statement-VI (See below).

(c) The 12th Five Year Plan for period from 2012 to 2017 has not been approved as on date. Therefore accurate estimate of number of houses to be completed for homeless poor sections in the next five years cannot be assigned at this juncture.

(d) and (e) Yes, the Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation received a reference from Government of Kerala for employment guarantee scheme in urban areas but the Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation has not given any assistance to any State for above scheme. However, the Government has already implemented an employment oriented urban poverty alleviation scheme targeting urban poor named Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rozgar Yojana (SJSRY).
