Fencing work along Indo-Pak border in Rajasthan

†1024. SHRI ASHK ALI TAK : Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether border along Rajasthan is most sensitive and longest Indo-Pak border;

(b) if so, the number of BSF check posts set up at present from security point of view and the number of Army check posts; and

(c) the part of the border where fencing work has been completed and the part where fencing is yet to be carried out?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN): (a) Sensitivity of border is dependent on many contributing factors from the border management perspective. Rajasthan border along Pakistan is 1037 km long and is a peaceful one. It is second largest after J&K international border with Pakistan.

(b) BSF and Army do not man any check posts in Rajasthan along Indo-Pak border. However, from security point of view, BSF has set up 270 nos. of Border Out Posts (BOPs) along Indo-Pak border in Rajasthan.

(c) A total of 1048.27 km of fencing has been completed on Indo-Pak Border in Rajasthan. Some unfenced stretches (about 8 km) lies in Jaisalmer sector due to problems of shifting sand dunes.

Incidents of violence in Assam even after cease fire

1025. SHRI BISWAJIT DAIMARY: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the reason behind extremist/terrorist activities in Assam even after the cease fire and peace talk with the different extremist groups; and

(b) how much long time will it take to come to a agreement or to find out a final solution to this problem?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN) : (a) and (b) The security situation in Assam has remained complex for quite some time because of diverse demands advocated by various outfits, but has shown improvement in the current year as compared to last year in terms number of incidents of violence and casualties of civilians.

In Assam while tripartite dialogue is presently underway with United Liberation Front of Asom (ULFA), a faction of ULFA led by Paresh Barua still continues to oppose the peace process. Besides, Tripartite talks are presently underway with Dima Haram Daogah (DHD)/N and DHD (Joel Garlosa), National Democratic Front of Bodoland/Progressive (NDFB-P). The government has appointed a Representative to negotiate with these groups in order to speed up the peace process. Gol Representative has also been authorized to initiate process of peace talks with National
