THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (PROF. SHER SINGH): (a) to (c) Proposals for providing textbooks to students at all stages of education at reasonable cost are being formulated for inclusion in the Fourth Five Year Plan.

In collaboration with the Governments of U. K., U. S. A. and U. S. S. R., cheap editions of standard educational works written in these countries are being made available to University students. Under another programme Indian publishers are given a subsidy to bring out cheap editions of standard books by Indian authors. The State Governments were not associated in the formulation of any of these schemes.
