(क) क्या यह सच है कि विदेशी ईसाई मिशनरी, साम्यवादी और पाकिस्तान समर्थक लोग बिहार में रांची, पालामाऊ, संथाल परगना तथा सहरसा जैसे कुछ जिलों में रहने वाले आदिवासियों को लोगों पर आक्रमण करने के लिये उकसा रहे हैं जिसके परिणाम स्वरूप सहरसा जिले में तीन किसान मारे गये और इस सम्बन्ध में पुलिस द्वारा गोली चलाये जाने के कारण रांची जिले में कुछ आदिवासी मारे गये ; और

(ख) यदि हां, तो इन राष्ट्र विरोधी तत्वों को दबाने के लिये सरकार द्वारा क्या कार्यवाही की जा रही है ?

INCITING OF TRIBALS BY FOREIGN CHRISTIAN MISSIONARIES

(a) whether it is a fact that foreign Christian Missionaries, Communists and pro-Pakistani elements are inciting tribals residing in some districts of Bihar, like Ranchi, Palamau, Santhal Pargana and Saharsa, to attack persons, and as a result of which three farmers of Saharsa district were killed and also some tribals of Ranchi district died as a result of police firing in connection therewith; and

(b) if so, what action is being taken by Government to suppress these anti-national elements?]
