(b) None of the study teams/working groups which have so far submitted their reports to the Administrative Reforms Commission has recommended the setting up of an advisory board to advise the President on all matters. The question of the State Governments being consulted does not therefore arise.

R. in order to examine the suitability of various aircraft for purchase by the Corporation. The final proposals of the Indian Airlines in this regard are expected shortly, which will be carefully considered by Government.
