THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C. M. POONACHA): (a) During the six months February to July, 1968, the punctuality performance of Nos. 396/395 Kazipet-Wardha Passenger trains has not been satisfactory.

(b) The factors contributing to late running of these and other trains on Kazipet-Wardha section are closely scrutinised and every possible effort is being made to eliminate all avoidable causes of detentions/late running.

THEFTS OF RAILWAY PROPERTY

to Questions

*498. SHRI S. K. VAISHAMPAYEN Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased

- (a) the value of the Railway property stolen and the amount of compensation paid by the Railways therefor from booked consignments on the Railways during the last five years from 1963 to 1967; and
- (b) the steps so far taken or proposed to be taken by Government to check these thefts?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C. M. POONACHA): (a) The value of Railway property stolen during the last five years, viz., 1962-63 to 1966-67 was Rs. 1.15 crores. No compensation is paid for railway property stolen. The amount of compensation paid for booked consignments stolen/pilferred during the last five years was Rs. 8.57 crores.

(b) The various measures taken by the Government to check thefts and pilferages are detailed in the statement laid on the Table of the Sabha.

STATEMENT

The following measures are taken to check the incidence of thefts in respect I of Railway property and booked con- signments:

Measures against the theft of Railway property

- 1. Plain clothes Railway Protection Force staff are deputed to collect crime intelligence with a view to tracking down known criminals.
- Special detective staff are detailed to collect intelligence regarding receivers of stolen property and raids are organised on their shops with the assistance of the Police.
- 3. Zonal Headquarters' as well as Railway Board's Central Crime Bureau staff are deployed to conduct surprise raids to effect red-handed capture of the culprits.
- Basic security measures are provided at all workshops and stores.
