†[BOMBS THROWN AT AJAL RADIO STATION

550. SHRI RAM SAHAI : Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state :

(a) the number of time bombs were thrown or found in the premises of the Aijal Radio Station during recent months; and

(b) the number of persons arrested in this connection and the details of prosecutions launched against them ?]

गृह-कार्य मंत्रालय में उपमंत्री (श्री के० एस० राम.स्वामी) : (क) 15 जून 1968 को आकाशवाणी के एजल केन्द्र के अहाते में दबा एक बिना फटा बम पड़ा था जिस पर केन्द्रीय रिजर्व पुलिस के एक कांस्टेबल ने अपने फावड़े से एक चोट मारी जब वह खोद रहा था। सामग्री की परीक्षा से यह विश्वास किया जाता है कि बम मार्च, 1966 में हमारे सुरक्षा दलों द्वारा चलाया गया था। बाद में खोज करने पर उस स्थल से एक अन्य वैसा ही बिना फटा बम और बरामद किया गया।

†[THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI K. S. RAMASWAMY) : (a) An unexploded shell lying buried in the compound of the Aijal Station of All India Radio exploded on the 15th of June, 1968, when a Constable of the Central Reserve Police hit it accidentally with his shovel while he was

digging. From an examination of the material, it is believed that the shell was fired by our Security Forces in March, 1966. Another similar unexploded shell was also recovered from the site on a subsequent search.

MYSORE CONFERENCE OF MARITIME STATES

551. SHRIMATI LALITHA (RAJA-GOPALAN) : Will the Minister of TRANSPORT AND SHIPPING be pleased to state the outcome of the Conference held at Mysore on June 26, 1968 which was attended by the Ministers of the maritime States ?

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT AND SHIPPING (PROF. V. K. R. V. RAO) : The Second Conference on Minor Ports held at Mysore on the 26th June 1968, recommended the revival of the old practice of taking up selected Minor Port Development Schemes as Centrally-sponsored Schemes. The Conference also broadly considered the approach to the development of minor ports during the Fourth Plan period and agreed that in order to take up the most remunerative schemes within the limited resources available, priorities should be drawn up from the point of view of traffic and other relevant economic considerations. The Conference also considered the dredging problems, and the fuller utilisation of the capacity of minor ports to handle foodgrains and fertilisers.
