

DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS SHRI OM MEHTA) : (a) According to the orders issued by Government in 1975, persons who participated in national movements and who entered government service on the basis of the relaxation of age-limit provided in the orders issued in 1948 and 1951 would be allowed to add to their service qualifying for superannuation pension the actual period not exceeding one-fourth of the length of their service or the actual period by which their age at the time of recruitment exceeded 25 years or a period of 5 years whichever is the laste.

(b) No directions have been given to the State Governments in this regard.
