- (a) whether Government have recently received any representation from the residents of Trinagar regarding deteriorating law and order situation in the area under Police Station Sarai Rohilla, Delhi;
- (b) whether Government have conducted any enquiry in this regard; if so, the outcome of the enquiry; and
- (c) if the answer to part (b) above be in the negative, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI OM MEHTA): (a) No such representation has been received from the residents of Trinagar.

(b) and (c) Do not arise.

SHRI SALIL KUMAR GANGULI: No supplementary, Sir.

SHRI KHURSHED ALAM KHAN: Apart from the unsatisfactory law and order situation in Sarai Rohilla police station, there are other places like Salempur and Khichripur, which may be new names for the hon. Minister, where the situation is also not good. I would like to know whether it is a fact that the present police set-up and strength is inadequate to meet the requirements adequately. What steps are being taken to improve it? Has the number of criminal cases not increased day by day?

SHRI OM MEHTA: I strongly refute the charge that there is an unsatisfactory law and order situation in Trinagar. There has been a lot of improvement as compared to last year. When you go through the cases which have come to our notice, you will see that it has decreased. If you like, I can give you the number also. In 1974 when the number of murders was 10, in 1975 it has been reduced to 5. The other position is a<sub>3</sub> under:
