

**Rent for buildings of ex-Maharaja of Jaipur**

741. SHRI SANAT KUMAR RAHA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that 50 to 60 buildings formerly belonging to the Maharaja of Jaipur and now vested in Government are still being occupied by ex-Maharaja's people;

(b) if so, whether rent is being paid for use of the premises; and

(c) if not, the steps taken so far to realise rent from the occupants?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI F. H. MOHSIN): (a) to (c) The Government of Rajasthan have intimated that in all 36 such buildings are in possession of the relatives and staff of the former ruler of Jaipur. In the inventory of private property of the former ruler of Jaipur provision had been for the use of certain State properties by the former ruler members of his family and household officers and also for the use of certain properties, which had been declared as private properties of the former ruler of Jaipur, by the State Government for official purposes. There is no provision for payment of rent by either party for the use of properties belonging to the other.
