(c) whether there is any backlog in so far as the representation of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes is concerned in these two categories; and

(d) if so, whether any special recruitment is proposed to be made to wipe out the backlog?

THE MINISTER OF REVENUE AND BANKING (SHRI PRANAB MUKHERJEE) : (a) and (b) The total number of Class III and Class IV employees in the Bangalore office of the Reserve Bank of India as on 30th June, 1976, the recruitments made and the number of promotions made in these categories of staff in that office during the years 1973 to 1976, as furnished by the Reserve Bank of India, are as follows :
