THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY* OF EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE (SHRI D. P. YADAV): (a) and (b) Urdu Academies have been set up in the States of Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Andhra Pradesh and Maharashtra. The Governments Karnataka, Rajasthan and West Bengal have also announced their decision to set up Urdu Academies.

(c) and (d) The proposal to set up an Urdu Academy in Delhi has been under the consideration of Delhi Administration for some time past. Paucity of funds with the Delhi Administration has been a factor in delaying their decision in the matter. Any proposal for setting up an Urdu Academy in Delhi that may be submitted by the Delhi Administration will be given due consideration by the Government of India.

Indo-Cuba Cultural Pact

- (a) whether it is a fact that an Indo-Cuba cultural agreement has been signed in July, 1976: and
- (b) if so, what are the main features of the agreement?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE (SHRI D. P. YADAV): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Agreement envisages cooperation in the fields of art and culture, education, science and technology, sports and games, mass media of information and education and journalism, in order to contribute towards a better knowledge and understanding of each other's cultures and activities in these fields. Financial Assistance to Major and **Minor Irrigation Projects**

- (a) what is the amount of Central assistance given to States, State-wise, during the last two years for minor and major irrigation schemes; and
- (b) what is the progress of the projects for which the Central assistance was extended?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION (SHRI KEDAR NATH SINGH): (a) Irrigation is a State subject and irrigation projects are financed by the State Governments from within their own resources. Central assistance to State Plans is given in the form of block loans and grants not related to any scheme or sector of development. However, an advance plan assistance of Rs. 55 -80 crores was given during 1975-76 for accelerating the construction of certain selected rirrigation schemes, as under :-
