The Genetic Engineering Approval Committee (GEAC) in the Ministry of Environment & Forests have notified certain Bt. Cotton hybrids for commercial cultivation after assessing the performance through various multi location and large scale field trials. The area covered under the Bt. Cotton is less compared to the other cotton varieties. No reports on failure has been received so far.
