Scheme for installing wind power generation plants

*315. SHRIMATI NAZNIN FARUQUE: Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government has any scheme/plan to install wind power generation plants to meet the power crisis in the country, especially in rural/village area;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) whether Government has made any criteria or rules to install such plants in the country?

THE MINISTER OF NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY (DR. FAROOQ ABDULLAH): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. Government is implementing a plan to install wind power generation plants in the country including rural/ village areas. A total wind power capacity of 17,875 MW has been installed in the country, and further development is taking place. The state-wise wind power installed capacity is given in Statement (*See* below).
