JJ cluster/slums in the country

2726. SHRI AAYANUR MANJUNATHA: Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of J.J. clusters/slums in the country;
- (b) whether any scheme had been implemented by the Government during the last three years to provide loan to the slum dwellers at concessional rates to build their houses; and
- (c) if so, the total number of urban poor who have been provided loans at concessional rates to build their houses during each of the last three years?

THE MINISTER OF HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION (KUMARI SELJA): (a) Slum is a State subject. According to the 65th Round NSS Survey (July, 2008-June, 2009), the estimated number of slums in the country is 48994.

(b) To enable the urban poor to obtain credit for home loans at affordable rates, this Ministry is implementing the Interest Subsidy Scheme for Housing the Urban Poor (ISHUP) which provides interest subsidy @ 5% on housing loans up to Rs. 1.00 lakh.

(c) As on 31.03.2012, 10,215 beneficiaries have been identified under ISHUP. The year wise progress under ISHUP during last three years are given in Statement.
