

**Pollution by industrial establishments in Madhya Pradesh**

(a) the details of the complaints received during the last ten years against different industrial establishments for polluting the Betwa river and ground water of Raisen district of Madhya Pradesh along with their names;

(b) the action taken on those complaints;

(c) whether any action has been taken against the polluting industrial establishments; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

The water quality of river Betwa is being regularly monitored by the MPPCB at various locations including at intake well Raisen.
