

Officers sent for foreign training

1327. SHRI AVINASH PANDE: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of IPS and officers of Paramilitary forces sent for foreign training by Government during the last one year;

(b) the estimated amount of money that was spent on their training;

(c) the average amount of money spent on the foreign training of IPS and officers of Paramilitary forces every year;

(d) is there a criterion for the selection of officers chosen for the training; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI R.P.N. SINGH): (a) The training of State Police personnel are planned and organized by their respective Governments. The Government of India supplements their efforts by sending Police personnel for training to the foreign countries. During last one year a total number of 459 (including IPS officers for MCTP courses) officers have been sent abroad for training. Details are given in Statement (See below).

(b) and (c) The expenditure was incurred by the respective organizations/State Governments in accordance with the entitlement of the officers.

(d) Yes, Sir.

(e) The nominations received from the respective States/Organizations are screened by the Screening Committee of MHA based on their service profile and nature of the course.
