Another project for widening to 4 lane road from Zarap (Km 450/0) to Patradevi/Goa border (Km 475/0) has also been taken up. The cost of project is Rs. 264.05 cr. The date of start is 26.10.2007 and is scheduled to be completed in March, 2013.
