factors. A high rate of investment is one of the prerequisites for sustained growth in GDP. Given some of these factors, high investment rates of around 37-38 per cent could help in achieving a higher rate of GDP growth.

(c) and (d) The ratio of gross fixed capital formation (as percentage of GDP at current market prices) (fixed investment) from 2000-01 to 2011-12 is given in the Table below.
