- (c) No such instance has been reported from Nagpur Region.
- (d) Does not arise, in view of reply at (c) above.

Reduction of service tax

3007. SHRI JAI PRAKASH NARAYAN SINGH: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that service tax in India is very high and is burden on common man;
- (b) if so, the complete details of service tax increase during the last ten years; and
- (c) the steps that Government proposes to take to reduce service tax in future on various items?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI S.S. PALANIMANICKAM): (a) Sir, with effect from the 1st day of April, 2012, rate of service tax is twelve per cent (excluding education cesses). This compares favorably with tax rates in many other countries.

- (b) Details of service tax increase during the last ten years, is given in the Statement (See below).
 - (c) No such steps are proposed.
