 $1666.\,$ SHRI DEVENDER GOUD T.: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the details of each of the 17 Government hospitals identified in Andhra Pradesh for strengthening of trauma care facilities;

- (b) the details of works undertaken in the said hospitals to strengthen trauma care facilities, hospital-wise;
- (c) the details of financial assistance provided during the Eleventh Plan for the hospitals so identified;
- (d) whether trauma care facilities have been upgraded in all these 17 hospitals; and
 - (e) if not, the reasons therefor, hospital wise?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD): (a) to (c) The details of 17 Government Hospitals identified during 11th Plan in Andhra Pradesh for strengthening of trauma care facilities, the works undertaken and the financial assistance provided hospital-wise, are as per Annexure.

(d) and (e) Out of 17 Hospitals, trauma care facilities have been made operational in 7 hospitals, namely Government General Hospital, Kurnool, District Hospital Sirkakulam, King George Hospital, Visakhapatnam, District Hospital, Rajahmundry, District Hospital, Eluru, District Hospital, Nellore and Area Hospital, Kamareddy.

Under the Scheme, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare releases funds for establishing and upgrading trauma care facilities. However, the responsibility for implementation of the scheme lies with the State Government.

The reasons why trauma care facilities could not be upgraded so far in all the 17 hospitals are given in Statement.
