

Houses under Indira Awas Yojana

‡2298. SHRI ASHK ALI TAK: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the number of houses proposed to be constructed under the Indira Awas Yojana in Rajasthan during 2012-13 alongwith the location thereof;

(b) the work completed out of it till now and by when the remaining work is likely to be completed; and

(c) the details of the sections of people which are getting the benefit of Indira Awas Yojana in that State?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI LAL CHAND KATARIA): (a) and (b) During the year 2012-13, against the physical target of construction of 68578 houses, 59781 houses have been completed so far under Indira Awaas Yojana. In addition to this, 25447 number of houses have been sanctioned for beneficiaries under Forest Right Act (FRA) in five districts and 43133 houses for Primitive Vulnerable Tribes Groups (PVTG) in 13 districts of Rajasthan. Houses under IAY are constructed by the beneficiaries themselves on their own land. Beneficiaries are expected to complete the houses during the financial year. But sometime construction work may get carried over to the next year also.

(c) Under Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY), Scheme, financial assistance is provided to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes, freed bonded labourers and other below the poverty line non-SC/ST rural households for construction/upgradation of dwelling units.
