#### **Diabetes as TB risk factor**

2435. SHRI BAISHNAB PARIDA: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a study has assessed diabetes as TB risk factor;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether some patients have been tested to ascertain the above risk; and
- (d) if so, the results thereof, hospital-wise, State/Union Territory-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI A.H. KHAN CHOUDHURY): (a) and (b) Yes. A number of systematic reviews and meta-analyses show that people with diabetes have a 2-3 times high risk of developing active TB than in those who do not have diabetes.

(c) and (d) Yes. A study was conducted by screening patients with diabetes

mellitus (DM) for tuberculosis (TB) within the healthcare setting of six diabetic clinics in tertiary hospitals. In this study, over 13000 diabetic patients were screened for TB and TB was detected in 254 patients.

Details of the results hospital-wise, State/Union Territory-wise are given in the Statement.
