THE MINISTER OF HEAVY INDUSTRY AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL): (a) and (b) Under the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) System, being implemented by the Government (Department of Public Enterprises), 17 Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) have taken the CAPEX Targets in the MoU 2012-13 as mentioned below:

(c) to (e) As per Public Enterprise Survey (2011-12) that was laid in the parliament on 26th and 27th February, 2013, plan outlay in CPSEs constituting internal resource (IR), extra-budgetary resources (EBR) and Budgetary Support (BS) showed a continuous increase in absolute terms during the last three years.
