(a) whether it is a fact that gas is being sold to the consumers for using it

as fuel in motor vehicles in Delhi and the National Capital Region such as Ghaziabad, Faridabad, Gurgaon etc.;

- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the total number of gas filling stations at all the aforesaid places;
- (c) the number of filling stations run by public sector and private sector, respectively;
  - (d) whether gas is sold at uniform rate at all these filling stations; and
- (e) if not, the prices at which gas is sold at filling stations of private sector and public sector, respectively?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRIMATI PANABAAKA LAKSHMI): (a) to (c) City Gas Distribution (CGD) companies operating in Delhi and NCR sell Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) for use as a fuel in motor vehicles. The number of CNG filling stations operating at Delhi, Noida, Greater Noida and Ghaziabad by Indraprastha Gas Limited, at Faridabad by Adani Gas Limited and at Gurgaon by Haryana City Gas Distribution Limited, are as follows:

(d) and (e) The price of CNG is a function of the weighted, average of the price of the gas (domestic gas/RLNG/Spot LNG), operating expenses, various Central, State and local taxes and levies. The retail price of CNG in any city is fixed by the CGD entity operating in the city.
