THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI JITENDRA SINGH): (a) There are 22 Nehru Yuva Kendras (NYKs) running in the State of Jharkhand as per the details given in the Statement-I (*See* below).

- (b) There are 24 districts in the State of Jharkhand, out of it there are NYKs in 22 districts The Kendras have not been established in 2 newly created districts namely Ramgarh and Khunti constituted after the recent bifurcation of the districts in the State.
- (c) and (d) At present, there is no proposal under consideration to establish any new Kendra of Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan. THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI JITENDRA SINGH): (a) No, Sir. Sports Authority of India (SAI) institutes/Campuses have never resorted to any illegal activity. To oversee that such activities do not take place, a Committee has been constituted which regularly conducts surprise visits to residential and training areas of national campers and other sportspersons.
