THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI SALMAN KHURSHEED): (a) to (d) No agreement has been entered into with the Italian Government in this regard. The case involving the two Italian marines remains *sub-judice*.

Direct Cash Transfer Scheme

- *430. DR. PRABHAKAR KORE: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that Government has introduced Direct Cash Transfer Scheme in the country;
 - (b) if so, the salient features of the scheme;
- (c) the details, State-wise and district-wise, where the scheme is successfully implemented and in operation;
- (d) whether Government is planning to extend the scheme throughout the country;
 - (e) if so, the details thereof; and
 - (f) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND PLANNING (SHRI RAJEEV SHUKLA): (a) Yes.

- (b) Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) roll out is based on the twin pillars of Aadhaar generation and financial inclusion of the beneficiaries. The salient features of DBT, *inter-alia*, are digitization of database of beneficiaries, their Aadhaar enrollment and opening of bank accounts and seeding of bank accounts and beneficiaries' database with Aadhaar number.
- (c) State-wise and district-wise details, where DBT is successfully implemented and in operation is given in Statement-I (See below).
- (d) to (f) Yes, in a phase-wise manner. Phase-I was initiated from 1.1.2013 in 43 districts and Phase-II is to be launched from 1.7.2013 in 78 districts given in Statement-II (*See* below). The DBT rollout depends on the preparedness of the district with regards to sufficient Aadhaar generation and financial inclusion.

†*431. SHRI DARSHAN SINGH YADAV: Will the Minister of PANCHAYATI RAJ be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of villages of Uttar Pradesh where elected panchayats do not exist as on date;
- (b) whether it has been envisaged in the report of the Tenth Finance Commission that the funds for the Panchayati Raj development are to be disbursed only to the elected panchayats; and
- (c) if so, the details of the funds allocated/released to panchayats so far during the last three years, State-wise and year-wise?

THE MINISTER OF PANCHAYATI RAJ (SHRI V. KISHORE CHANDRA DEO):
(a) As per information received from State Government, Elections have been held

- to all Panchayats in the State of U.P. However, in 10 Gram Panchayats though elections were held but Pradhans could not be elected due to non-filling of elections papers.
- (b) As per the guidelines issued for utilisation of the grants from the Government of India to the State Governments for Local Bodies based on the recommendations of the Tenth Finance Commission, these Grants were to be given only in respect of elected local bodies wherever such elections were mandatory under the Constitution.
- (c) Details of Basic and Performance Grants allocated and released to Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) as per recommendations of 13th Finance Commission during the last three years is given in Statement (See below).
