THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION (SHRI BHARATSINH SOLANKI): (a) As per Census 2011, nearly 67.33 % of rural households (11.30 crore rural households) do not have access to toilets whereas nearly 65% of rural households (10.90 crore rural households) do not have access to drinking water within premises.
