THE MINISTER OF CULTURE (SHRIMATI CHANDRESH KUMARI KATOCH): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. The Institute of Archival Training was set up in National Archives of India (NAI) in 1976 and was renamed as School of Archival Studies in 1980. The School was established to meet the demand of trained custodians of archival and library wealth. The school conducts theory and practical classes to train Archivists, Record Managers, Preservationists and Microphotographists. The training programme is supplemented by seminars, workshops and extension lectures by eminent Archivists, Preservationists and Microphotographists from leading institutions and universities.
