- (b) 534 km of Sonnagar Dankuni section on Eastern DFC is to be implemented through Public Private Partnership (PPP).
- (c) Western DFC is targeted to be commissioned in 2018 and Eastern DFC in 2019.

Railway projects in Maharashtra

- 1829. DR. BHARATKUMAR RAUT: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :
- (a) the status of sanctioning of projects of laying new railway lines, doubling the tracks and widening of existing lines in Maharashtra which are long pending before the Ministry;
- (b) whether Government has prepared any time-frame in this regard for providing adequate Central funds for ongoing and new railway projects in Maharashtra;
 - (c) if so, the present status of the funds allocated; and
 - (d) the reasons for delay in sanctioning railway projects in the State?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K. J. SURYA PRAKASH REDDY): (a) A total of 19 surveys for New Line, Gauge Conversion and Doubling of lines in Maharashtra have been completed and are pending before the Ministry. Of these, 9 survey reports for New Lines, 2 survey reports for Gauge Conversion and 1 Survey report for Doubling are under examination in the Ministry and 7 survey reports of New Line have been sent to Planning Commission for getting "In principle approval."

- (b) and (c) Funds are provided yearly as per the availability of resources for completion of projects. An outlay of Rs. 823.33 crore have been provided for 2013-14 for ongoing projects falling fully/partly in Maharashtra.
- (d) Railway projects are taken up after conducting techno-economic studies. Sanctioning of projects is a continuous process and projects are sanctioned every year during a five year plan.
