Modules of SIMI being set up in the country

*311. DR. K.P. RAMALINGAM: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that modules of the banned Students Islamic Movement of India (SIMI) are being set up in many parts of the country, if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether it is also a fact that the central intelligence agencies are investigating the matter; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI R.P.N. SINGH): (a) to (c) Reports have been received from various States/Union Territories and investigation agencies about continued activities of the Students Islamic Movement of India (SIMI) which are prejudicial to the integrity and security of the State and have the potential of disturbing peace and communal harmony and disrupting the secular fabric of the country.

Many States/UTs/NIA are reported to have registered cases against ex-SIMI cadres and have also reported convictions.

The Central Government has since declared SIMI as an unlawful association under the provisions of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 on 1st February, 2014 for a period of five years.

Schemes for welfare of handloom sector and handloom weavers

*312. SHRIMATI KUSUM RAI: Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

(a) the State-wise and scheme-wise details of funds allocated, released, spent on schemes being run for welfare of handloom sector and handloom weavers in the country during the current financial year, till date;

(b) the details of fund allocated, released and spent on welfare of handloom sector and handloom weaves in Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh, district-wise during the current financial year; and

(c) the State-wise and scheme-wise details of handloom weavers covered by these schemes during the current financial year, so far along with district-wise details in case of Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh?

THE MINISTER OF TEXTILES (DR. KAVURU SAMBA SIVA RAO): (a) The Government of India, Ministry of Textiles has been implementing the following developmental and welfare schemes during current year in the country for handloom sector and handloom weavers:

1. Comprehensive Handlooms Development Scheme (CHDS)
2. Handloom Weavers Comprehensive Welfare Scheme
3. Mill Gate Price Scheme (MGPS)
4. Revival Reform and Restructuring (RRR) Package

The scheme-wise fund allocated, released and spent during 2013-14 till 31.1.2014 is given below:

Out of the above schemes, the fund is released to State Governments under Comprehensive Handloom Development Scheme (CHDS) only alongwith other implementing agencies and fund is released directly to implementing agencies in other schemes. Under CHDS, state-wise fund is not allocated and financial assistance is released on need basis on receipt of viable proposals from states. The State-wise fund spent during current year till 31.1.2014 under CHDS is given in Statement-I (*See below*).

(b) For welfare of handloom weavers, the Government is implementing Handloom Weavers Comprehensive Welfare Scheme (HWCWS), which has two components *viz.* Health Insurance Scheme to provide access to health care facilities and Mahatma Gandhi Bunkar Bima Yojana to provide life insurance cover. Under the scheme, the fund is released to implementing agencies directly and State and district-wise fund is not released. The fund allocated, released and spent under HWCWS for entire country is given in the table under para-(a) above. However, the district-wise beneficiaries covered in Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh under HWCWS during current year till 31.01.2014 is given in Statement-II (*See below*).

(c) The State-wise and scheme-wise details of handloom weavers covered under, HWCWS, MGPS, RRR Package and CHDS during current financial year is given in Statement-III (*See below*). The district-wise beneficiaries covered in Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh under various schemes is given Statement-IV (*See below*).
