THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI JITENDRA SINGH): (a) and (b) The year-wise details of Inter-State Youth Exchange Programme organised by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports through its organisations viz., National Service Scheme, Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan, Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development in the country and amount spent from 2009 to December, 2013 are as given below:

During the above period 2515 NTCs have been organised for the youths of the country. This Ministry also organises National Youth Festival (under the Scheme of National Programme for Youth and Adolescent Development) every year in collaboration with one of the States from 12th January to 16th January to bring youths into the national stream with an object to propagate the concept of National integration, spirit of communal harmony, brotherhood, customs and cultural Heritage of all states.
