approximately Rs. 3,850.00 Cr for the Twelfth Plan period. RRY scheme has been started in October, 2013. Hence, beneficiaries are yet to be benefitted under this scheme, however, under its predecessor scheme ISHUP in the last two years *i.e.* in financial year 2011-12, 241 beneficiaries and in financial year 2012-13, 157 beneficiaries have been benefitised.

## Efforts to reduce slums in Andhra Pradesh

2396. SHRI DEVENDER GOUD T.: Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Andhra Pradesh is the second State in the country where there are more number of slums;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that more than one crore people are living in slums in Andhra Pradesh as per the latest figures; and
- (c) if so, the reasons for this downtrend in Andhra Pradesh and what special efforts the Ministry is putting to reduce slums in the State?

THE MINISTER OF HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION (DR. GIRIJA VYAS): (a) and (b) As per the data released by National Sample Survey Organisation (NSSO) on estimated number of slum and slum households in the urban area of the country in its report "Key Indicators of Urban Slums in India" based on its 69th round (July, 2012-December, 2012) sample survey, an estimated number of slums in Andhra Pradesh are 4539 and 15.98 lakh estimated households lived in these slums. Details of estimated number of slums and number of slum households in Andhra Pradesh are given below:

As per the data released by Registrar General of India (RGI) on slums population in Primary Census Abstract for Slum as a part of the Population Census-2011, a total of 65.5 million people are living in slums of 2613 cities/towns out of 4041 statutory towns spread across 31 States and Union Territories in the 2011 Census of India. Slums in the 125 slum reported towns of Andhra Pradesh account for 10.18 million population, which is 15.55 percent of the total population of the country. Details of slum population in Andhra Pradesh are given below:

(c) The Government of India launched Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) on 3rd December, 2005 to assist States/UTs in taking up housing and infrastructural facilities including basic facilities/amenities for the urban poor/slum dwellers in 65 select cities in the country under Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP) Programme. For other Cities/Towns, the Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) was launched. The duration of the Mission was upto 31.3.2012 which has been extended upto the March, 2015 for completion of projects sanctioned upto March, 2012.

In pursuance of Government's vision of "Slum free India", Rajiv Awas Yojana (RAY) was launched in June, 2011 in two phases; the preparatory phase for a period of two years which ended in June, 2013 and implementation phase. The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, after making an assessment of the pace of preparatory phase, has now approved the implementation phase of RAY for the period of 2013-2022.

Since inception of the Scheme a total of 39 projects under Basic Services to

the Urban Poor (BSUP), 74 projects under Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) and 5 projects under Rajiv Awas Yojana has been approved so far for construction/up gradation of 139854, 39914 and 3731 houses respectively along with Basic infrastructure facilities in the state of Andhra Pradesh.
